Wayne Preparatory Academy Frequently Asked Questions (FAQ)

How do I apply to have my child(ren) attend Wayne Preparatory Academy during the 2018-19 school year?

Applications are available on our website, <u>wpanc.org</u>, for the 2018-19 school year. You can also contact the school at **919-734-8085** if you need support in completing your child's application.

What if I'd like to enroll multiple siblings?

You'll need to fill out an application for each individual child you'll be enrolling.

What if I want to learn more about the school prior to completing my child's application?

We have a spring and summer full of events planned where Wayne families and staff will be available to answer questions. Explore our calendar and sign up for an event to learn more about what Wayne Preparatory Academy (WPA) can offer you and your family.

What if one of my children already attends WPA, do I have to fill out an application again?

Children who currently attend WPA do not have to reapply. You're in!

I have a child who attends WPA and want to enroll a sibling, do I have to complete an application?

Yes. If you have a child that currently attends WPA and wish to apply for an additional sibling to attend, you'll need to complete an application for the additional child.

Wayne Preparatory Academy does provide placement priority to siblings of currently attending children to the extent that space is available.

How will I know if my application was submitted correctly?

You will see a prompt that will verify your successful submission after pushing the Submit button... You'll also receive an informational email from WPA.

What should I do if I don't receive the informational email?

Contact Wayne Preparatory Academy at: <u>ADMISSIONS@WPANC.ORG.</u> In the body of the email please type: Inquiry into application submission for "Student Last Name, First Name." A WPA Team Leader will respond with an update regarding your inquiry.

What do I do if my child is accepted to attend WPA?

Any student admitted to WPA needs to complete the enrollment process by turning in a completed Registration Packet as an indicator of acceptance. We need confirmation quickly to be fair to all students interested in attending WPA.

Registration Packets are available in the main office of the school.

Students admitted to WPA as of the Lottery date (April 25, 2018) will have until May 10, 2018 at 3:45 PM to accept or decline enrollment.

Students admitted between June 1, 2018 and August 13, 2018 will have three (3) days to accept or decline enrollment at the school by submitting completed Registration Packets.

Any remaining slots as of August 14, 2017 will be available on a first come, first served basis to remaining - waitlisted - students.

At any time in the application process if the school does not receive the Registration Packet within the specified time period, the Managing Director may decline enrollment and proceed to open those slots to the waitlist.

What do I do if my child is not accepted to attend Wayne Preparatory Academy?

In the event that a lottery is held, and some applicants are not accepted into WPA, a waitlist will be generated and those applicants will carry their lottery number onto the waitlist.

Rolling Enrollment will remain open through the first 40 days of the 2018-19 school year. If space becomes available during that time the school will fill those spaces using the waitlist.

Parents and Guardians with children on the waitlist will receive periodic updates on the status of the waitlist. It is not uncommon for a charter school to fill 10-15 spaces using their waitlist prior to the close of enrollment in October.
